## Promoting Interoperability (PI) and MIPS 2020 Countdown

Preparing for the Final Reporting Window



**July 8, 2020** - Promoting Interoperability and MIPS Year 4 require reporting for a minimum of 90 continuous days in 2020. The last possible date to begin your 2020 reporting period for the objective measures is **October 3, 2020**.

If your organization has not yet met the milestones below, MEDITECH recommends that you begin working toward meeting these milestones **by the end of July 2020**; otherwise, you're at risk for not meeting the reporting deadline for 2020 and incurring the associated penalties.

**eCQMs:** For EHs and CAHs, you're required to report one calendar quarter for the Electronic Clinical Quality Measures (eCQMs) with the last quarter beginning on **October 1, 2020**. For ECs reporting to MIPS Year 4, quality reporting remains a full year.

The following actions should be underway for implementing your selected measures:

- Review your selected measures for any required edits or nomenclature mapping that may need to be completed.
- **I** Train staff on the workflows required to meet the measures.
- Download the 2020 versions of your MEDITECH SQL reports. Test the reports once the build and workflows are in place to ensure the measure data is reflected accurately.

**Objective Measures:** For EHs, CAHs, and ECs, you're required to report a minimum of 90 continuous days in 2020. The last possible date to begin your 2020 reporting period for the objective measures is **October 3, 2020**.

The following actions should be underway for implementing the four objectives:



#### <sup>J</sup> E-Prescribing

- Contract with your e-Prescribing gateway partner, such as Dr First.
- **I** Train staff on the best practice workflows required to meet the measure.
- Download the 2020 versions of your MEDITECH SQL report for the e-Prescribing measure. Test the reports once the build and workflows are in place to ensure the measure data is reflected accurately.
- Optional: Set up access to a Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) for the bonus measure, which may align with your state regulations. Note: This bonus measure Query of PDMP is a Yes/No attestation.



#### <sup>7</sup> Provider to Patient Exchange

- □ As set up for 2019, your organization should have an organizational strategy for providing patients access and onboarding any apps that a patient presents.
- $\hfill\square$  Best practice build and workflow changes should be in progress.
- $\hfill\square$  Train staff on the best practice workflows required to meet the measure.
- Download the 2020 versions of your MEDITECH SQL reports. Test the reports once the build and workflows are in place to be sure the measure data is reflected accurately.



#### Measure 1: Support Electronic Referral Loops by Sending Health Information

- Implement the 2015 CEHRT compliant Summary of Care Record.
- Build the fields required for the 2015 CEHRT CDA.
- Best practice build and workflow changes should be in progress.
- Train staff on the best practice workflows required to meet the measure.
- Download the 2020 versions of your MEDITECH SQL reports. Test the reports once the build and workflows are in place to ensure the measure data is reflected accurately.

#### Measure 2: Support Electronic Referral Loops by Receiving and Incorporating Health Information

- Complete testing the Inbound CCD/Direct interface to confirm you have the ability to receive inbound CCDs. Refer to this <u>communication</u> for the latest information if your inbound interface is **not** implemented yet.
- Best practice build and workflow used to consume, review and reconcile external medications, allergies and problems should be in progress.
- **I** Train staff on the best practice workflows required to meet the measure.
- Download the 2020 versions of your MEDITECH SQL reports. Test the reports once the build and workflows are in place to be sure the measure data is reflected accurately.



### Public Health and Clinical Data Exchange

- □ If you are using MEDITECH's Immunizations or Syndromic Surveillance interfaces, implementation & testing of the updated interfaces should be complete.
- Best practice build and workflow changes should be in progress.
- **□** Train staff on the best practice workflows required to meet the measures.

#### Other reporting requirements for EH/CAH and MIPS ECs

- Complete the Security Risk Analysis measure for the 2020 reporting year
- Review <u>Prevention of Information Blocking</u> requirements
- Review <u>ONC Direct Review Attestation</u> requirements

#### Improvement Activities category for MIPS ECs

- From 105 activities available in 2020, ECs or groups must submit one of the following combinations: two high-weighted activities; one high-weighted activity and two medium-weighted activities; or four medium-weighted activities
- Each activity must be performed for 90 continuous days or more during 2020.
- □ For group-reporting, at least 50% of the group must perform the same activity for any continuous 90 days.
