


Moving Forward with Mobility: What's Your Strategy?

Plan ahead

Best practice for implementations includes evaluating your environment. Start preparing for your implementation process well in advance, and consider implementing Expanse Point of Care before, or concurrently with, Expanse Patient Care.

Device Strategy

Are mobile devices and laptops factored into your budget? What about collateral, such as power cords, docking stations, sleds, and tracking systems to keep track of devices.

Plan for dedicating IT staff to set up users on devices.



Hardware & Infrastructure

Determine if additional hardware needs to be purchased.


