### WITH ONE STEP: Exchange Clinical Orders and Results

Exchange orders with other physicians across care environments, with results linking back to the originating EHR.

#### PATIENT PORTAL

Frank accesses MEDITECH's Patient and Consumer Health Portal to schedule an appointment with his GP from home after experiencing shortness of breath.

Frank's GP refers him to an outpatient cardiologist's clinic.

#### LOCAL CARDIAC CLINIC

Cardiologist sends testing orders for possible Acute Heart Failure to a tertiary care hospital.

#### DOWNTOWN TORONTO TERTIARY CARE HOSPITAL

Frank's orders flow to the tertiary care hospital's other vendor EHR via **One Step** in Traverse. Frank is diagnosed with AHF and admitted.

Frank is discharged from the cardiac rehabilitation clinic within his local hospital and returns home.

Frank's providers use **One View** in Traverse to see all his clinical data in one centralized location — including lab results, medication orders, and his post-op discharge care plan — from the EHR used in the downtown Toronto office.

The coronary artery bypass graft (CABG) is completed and documented within the Toronto hospital's EHR. Frank returns to his local facility for cardiac rehabilitation post op.

Providers in tertiary care can access Expanse with **One Touch** via Traverse to view Frank's history. The cardiologist's initial orders are available within one step.
