Introduction

Members of the Nursing Collaborative will serve as subject matter experts and provide guidance, recommendations, and conceptualization to enhance safety and efficiency of nursing practices through the use of MEDITECH software. Stakeholders

MEDITECH Stakeholders will consist of members of Client Services. The internal stakeholders will engage other groups and divisions as needed.

Membership

Committee members must be in a nursing role at a MEDITECH Hospital. Requirements of membership include:

- Members will be expected to attend and actively participate in Quarterly meetings
- Meetings will be held virtually
- Membership is required for attendance
- Membership will be reviewed annually
- Failure to attend meetings may result in the loss of membership
- Member(s) will be expected to engage in customer collaboration that emanate from this committee
- Member must notify MEDITECH within 10 business days of the scheduled meeting if they are unable to attend due to conflicting obligations
- Meeting logistics:
 - Meeting dates will be determined at the start of each year.
 - Members will have the opportunity to contribute to the agenda for a period prior to the agenda being made available.
 - Meeting agendas will be made available prior to the scheduled meeting
 - Attendance will be documented at the start of each meeting
 - Members will be expected to provide a quick summary of what they are currently working on at their facility
 - Minutes and action items to be distributed to all members after the meetings
- There is no stipend for participation and no dues will be incurred as a part of membership.
