

MEDITECH's ONC Health IT Certified Ambulatory and Oncology Product Listings on the Certified Health IT Product List (CHPL)

Eligible Clinicians (ECs)

This document provides guidance for Eligible Clinicians (ECs) on how to locate and understand which products and components to select when generating a CMS EHR Certification ID on the Certified Health IT Product List (CHPL) [website](#). Please note, if your organization is attesting for Ambulatory and/or Oncology ECs and Acute Eligible Hospitals (EHs) and Critical Access Hospitals (CAHs), your organization will need to obtain **two separate certification IDs** - one for ECs and one for EH/CAH.

The CMS Electronic Health Record (EHR) Certification Identifiers (IDs) will be available through the Certified Health IT Product List (CHPL) beginning on September 1st. The IDs will reflect the 2026 CMS program reporting year with a year-based prefix of "2026C." Users who still need a 2025C ID for the 2025 reporting year will continue to be able to generate one through December 31, 2026. During this overlap period, the CHPL CMS ID Creator will allow users to select either the 2025 or 2026 reporting year when generating an ID. Your organization must fill your cart to complete the Electronic Health Record (EHR) requirements and generate a CMS EHR Certification ID. By choosing the CHPL listing options to obtain your CMS EHR Certification ID, you are attesting that your organization possesses each of the components selected. **When adding the components to the cart, keep the following in mind:**

- If you are using more than one certified version during the same reporting period (e.g., LIVE with 6x for a portion of the period and Expanse for the rest), you must add all certified products for both releases to the cart to generate the CMS EHR Certification ID.
- For CY 2026 reporting, you are required to use *ONC health IT certification criteria* certified products.

- In the event of an Audit, the CMS EHR Certification ID is what defines the different certified components that were possessed.

Below are the steps to assist in identifying the correct certified products on the ONC CHPL [website](#).

Step 1: Utilize Filters on the Certified Health IT Product List (CHPL) site to identify the listings specific to your product and release.

Step 2: Select the appropriate certified products — see guidance below.

Step 3: Select your ONC health IT certified Health Information Service Provider (HISP).

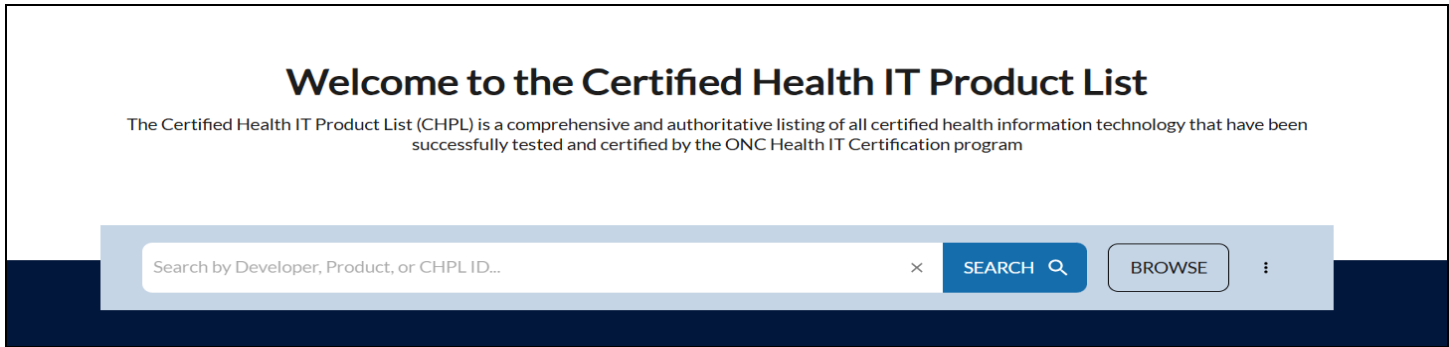
Step 4: If using another vendor for reporting, select the appropriate certified products for your other vendor's objective and quality reporting.

Step 1: Certified Health IT Product List (CHPL) Search Feature

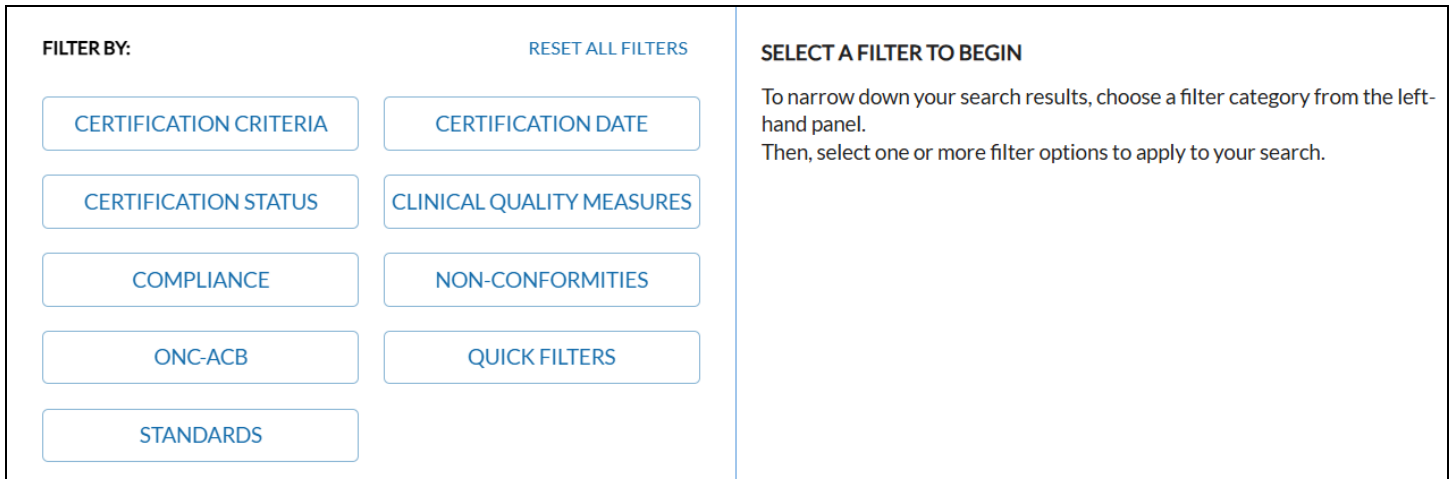
A list of MEDITECH’s certified products can be found on our [Certification Page](#). As noted above, if more than one certified version was used during the same reporting period (e.g., you updated from one certified release to another during the reporting period), you must add products for both releases to your cart to generate your CMS EHR Certification ID. To generate a Certification ID, navigate to the [CHPL website](#).

Note: CHPL has redesigned their website, so please review the information below on filter settings.

In the search box, enter MEDITECH and select SEARCH.



The **FILTERS** option (3 dots) on the right allows you to filter by several categories, as shown below:

Step 2: Selecting Certified Product(s)

Once you have filtered your search, the page displays your search results. Select the yellow “Cert ID +” button to the right of the product(s) you want to add to the CMS ID Creator widget.

Certified Product Listings

1. Using the filters defined on the previous page, find and select the appropriate ambulatory listing that applies to your platform and version number. These listings are as follows:

- MEDITECH Expanse 2.2 Ambulatory v2.2c
- MEDITECH Expanse Ambulatory v2.1c
- MEDITECH Expanse 2.2 Oncology v2.2c
- MEDITECH Expanse 2.1 Oncology v2.1c
- MEDITECH 6.1 Oncology v6.15c

Please note, if you are using MEDITECH's Traverse Exchange solution, there is no additional product specific to Traverse Exchange that needs to be added beyond including your HISP and your Ambulatory and/or Core HCIS products.

2. After selecting the appropriate listing above, you will select the MEDITECH or Other Vendor product used for each of the following (if applicable):

- Core HCIS
 - The Core HCIS must be added as relied upon software for the Ambulatory and/or Oncology product.
- Continuity of Care (CCD) Interface Suite
- Public Health: Immunizations
- Public Health: Electronic Case Reporting (ECR)
- Public Health: Syndromic Surveillance
- Public Health: Electronic Lab Result Reporting
- Cancer Case Reporting
- My Health Portal (PHM)

When searching on CHPL for the ONC Health IT criteria MEDITECH products:

- MEDITECH's Continuity of Care (CCD) Interface is listed by version number *only* and not by platform. The certified versions for MEDITECH's CCD is as follows: v6.1c (use for 6.1 & Expanse).
- MEDITECH's Patient Health Portal is listed by version number *only* and not by platform. The certified versions for the Patient Portal v2.0c are used for all software platforms.
- MEDITECH's Public Health Interfaces are listed by version number *only* and not by platform. All of the Public Health Interfaces are ONC health IT editions. The certified versions for MEDITECH's Public Health Interfaces is as follows: v6.1 (use for 6.1 & Expanse). All Public Health Interfaces are ONC Health IT criteria certified versions.

Step 3: Select your Certified HISP

Back on the **SEARCH** option, find and select your ONC health IT certified other vendor HISP.

Your HISP must be added to your cart to reach 100% for the Base Criteria and generate a Certification ID.

If you are having difficulty locating your certified HISP on the CHPL website, we recommend either reaching out to your HISP for assistance Or the following filters can be used to display a list of all ONC Health IT criteria certified HISPs.

Under the heading of CERTIFICATION CRITERIA in the filters, checkmark "170.315 (h)(1) Direct Project" and "170.315 (h)(2) Direct Project, Edge Protocol, and XDR/XDM" in the Active column and select CLOSE.

Step 4: Electronic Clinical Quality Measure (eCQM) Reporting Products

MEDITECH offers certified SQL Reports for eCQM reporting. If you are using our SQL reports, MEDITECH's Ambulatory and Oncology product listings are inclusive of eCQMs, so no additional selections need to be made. If you are using a third party for Quality Reporting, you will need to locate and select that vendor's certified product listing.

CMS ID Creator Widget

The "CMS ID Creator" widget will drop down automatically and appear as products are added. As you add products to the widget by selecting the yellow "Cert ID +" button, notice that the base and CQM criteria increase towards 100%. Continue adding all product listings used during the performance period, even if the total has already reached 100%.

Please Note: In order to obtain 100% you need to add ALL items of software being used for attestation. This includes non-MEDITECH software, other vendors, and HISPs.
